-of the 371 candidates, 284 were not elected.

- of the 28 parties, only 3 had any success.

The Liberals and NDP both ran 87 candidates, the Greens 83. The Libertarians 30. The Conservatives and one other ran 10 candidates. The remaining parties had less than 10 candidates. There were also 33 independent candidates.

42.3% of people eligible to vote did not vote. While this is a small increase over the numbers who voted in 2013 and 2009, it must be remembered that in the 1980's 77% of eligible voters voted.
